Guidance

It is important to explain the words as they are used in the text, not in a more general way. If you don't know any of the meanings, you may be able to deduce them from the context. For example, in 'twilight or early morning walks', the phrase 'early morning' suggests that 'twilight' must be another time of day.

Marking

There are 8 marks available, 2 marks for each word. A partial explanation of a word would earn you only 1 mark, e.g. if you wrote 'Twilight is a time of day.'

Explain fully, linking the meaning to the story where appropriate, to show the examiner that you understand.
